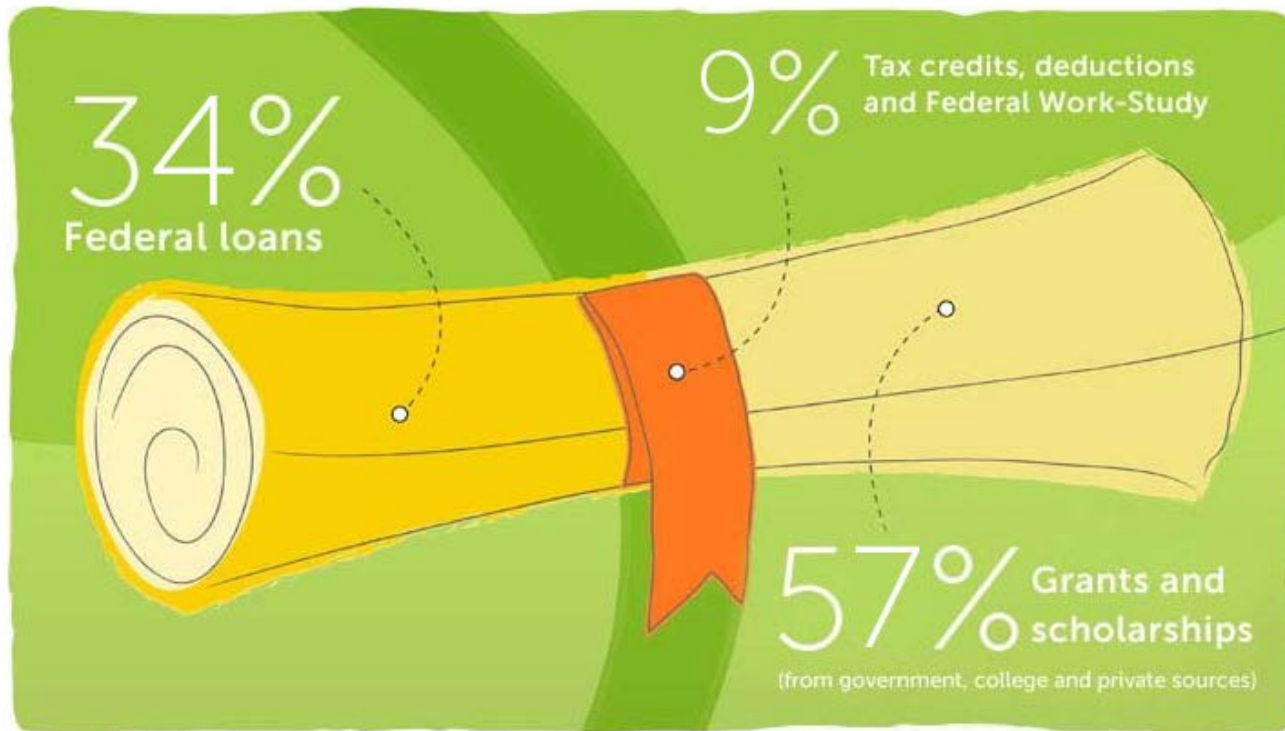

Quick scholarship distinction

- External – Scholarships earned outside school. You can take with you.

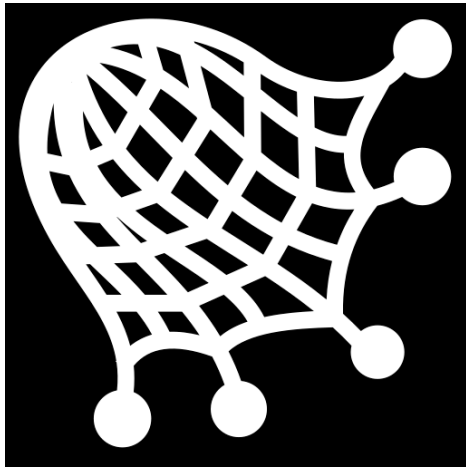
