### **The University of North Georgia Military Scholarship (UNGMS) Dahlonega:**

We have 42 Georgia Military Scholarships to award to high school seniors. These are full scholarships that pay for room, meals, tuition, fees, books, and uniforms for all four years at (UNG) – a Senior Military College. In addition, recipients receive monthly pay and stipends for serving as enlisted members of the Georgia Army National Guard while being full time students and Cadets at UNG. The scholarship is worth approximately \$70,000 over four years. Criteria: Seniors in excellent physical condition, have above a 3.0 cumulative GPA. Interested students must be accepted for admission to UNG in a "regular admit" status.
